

Greetings! I echo the sentiment of the Grand Chef; another poor turnout at Cheminot. It seems we have many Voitures out there who have little to no connection with the Grand, let alone Nationale.

The way it is supposed to work is that each Voiture is part of a district. The district elects/appoints a Cheminot to represent their Voitures. The Cheminot is the liaison between the Voitures and Grand. They should have frequent contact with the Voitures

in their district and report to Fall and Spring Cheminot on specific items. They take relevant information back to the Voitures. Issues that need to be addressed to Nationale are forwarded by Grand for action. Information should flow up and down. This is called COMMUNICATION. We need some.
