Snow Removal Efforts

The Town of Rockford believes that it is in the best interest of the residents for the town to assume basic responsibility for control of snow and ice on town streets. Reasonable ice and snow control is necessary for routine travel and emergency services.

- **The Public Works operator will decide when to begin snow or ice control operations.**
 - **When possible, please keep cars parked off the street.**
 - **Do not push snow into town street, it will likely end up back in your driveway.**
- **Keep fire hydrants clear of snow and DO NOT PARK WITHIN 15 FEET OF THEM. This is an actual law that is in effect year-round.**
 - **Be sure to remove garbage cans from the street as soon as possible.**

Sewer Improvements Project

In the fall of 2022, the town applied for and was approved for a grant through Spokane County. The County received grant funds for the “American Rescue Plan” for infrastructure related projects and Rockford is fortunate enough to be one of the towns selected. The project is for “sewer collection pipe improvements connecting to Pacific and extending to Weaver and Pine Streets.”

We are excited to get the project going, as we know it will drastically reduce the ground water seepage into our sewer system and help protect our wastewater treatment facility.

The project is scheduled to start 2023-2024.
