

**NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION
FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT SIX
EAST BATON ROUGE PARISH**

Pursuant to the provisions of a resolution adopted on May 18, 2021, by the Board of Commissioners of FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT SIX of the Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana (the "District"), after all required and appropriate legal notice and proceedings, acting as the governing authority of said District, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special election previously scheduled and noticed to be held in the Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana on Saturday, November 13, 2021, **has been rescheduled for SATURDAY, DECEMBER 11, 2021**, by Executive Order No. 2021 JBE 13 due to statewide emergency caused by Hurricane Ida, and that at the election there will be submitted to all registered voters of the District, qualified and entitled to vote at the said election under the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana and the United States Constitution, the following proposition, to-wit:

PROPOSITION

Shall the Fire Protection District Six (also known as Fire Protection District 6) in East Baton Rouge Parish, State of Louisiana (the "District"), under the provisions of Article VI, Section 19 of the 1974 Constitution of Louisiana, Part I of Chapter 7 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes, La. R.S. 40:1501 *et seq.*, as amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority, be authorized to renew and continue the levy and collection of the *ad valorem* property tax of fifteen (15) mills (the "Tax") in each calendar year on all property subject to taxation in the District for a period of ten (10) years, commencing in and including the year 2022 to and including the year 2031, which estimated amount of such tax reasonably expected to be collected from such levy renewal is approximately \$802,708.56 for each entire year of the levy, and shall the avails or proceeds of said Tax be used entirely and exclusively for salaries and benefits for all employees of Fire Protection District Six, purchasing fire protection equipment, and maintaining and operating the fire protection facilities of Fire Protection District Six of the Parish of East Baton Rouge?

This special election will be held at the following polling places situated within the district limits of Fire Protection District Six, in the Parish of East Baton Rouge, which polls will open at seven o'clock a.m. (7:00 a.m.), and close at eight o'clock p.m. (8:00 p.m.), in compliance with the provisions of Section 541 of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes (La. R.S. 18:541), as amended, to wit:

Notice pursuant to La. R.S. 18:1285.A(1)(a)(iii): A portion of the monies collected shall be remitted to certain state and statewide retirement systems in the manner required by law.

Notice pursuant to La. R.S. 18:1285(A)(1)(a)(v): The estimated cost of the election as determined by the Secretary of State for the Fire Protection District Six Tax special election is \$32,300.00.

The said special election will be held in accordance with the applicable provisions of Chapter 5, Chapter 6 and Chapter 6-A of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority supplemental thereto, and the officers appointed to hold the said election, as provided in this Notice of Special Election, or such substitutes therefore as may be selected and designated in accordance with Title 18, Section 1287 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 (La. R.S. 18:1287), and as amended, shall make due returns thereof to the Board of Commissioners of Fire Protection District Six. NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that said Board of Commissioners will meet at its regular meeting place, the Fire Protection District Six station and headquarters, 7878 Prescott Road, Baton Rouge, Louisiana

70812, on TUESDAY, DECEMBER 14, 2021, at FIVE (5:00) O’CLOCK P.M., and shall then and there in open and public session proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the result of the said special election. All registered voters in Fire Protection District Six in the Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana are entitled to vote at said special election and voting machines will be used at the polling places.
