She then selects from all states that sent entries in our Division one entry from each class to submit to National competition.

Something new is that the Division Poster winner will receive a \$50.00 check along with their citation and also there will be a \$50.00 donation in their name to the Children of Warriors Presidential Scholarship.

Poppy money can be used to provide school supplies such as poster beard and drawing materials for the Poppy Poster Contest. This may encourage your school to participate.

A suggestion: You may be able to hang your posters not sent in on a wall in your Post. Send a photo to the teacher to show the students and make the all feel a winner.

Miss Poppy Contest: Miss Poppy is a time honored tradition that goes back to the mid /late 1950's. She is a great way to help us, to help your Unit promote what the poppy program is. We all know that children & puppies are the best attention getters in public places. People see Miss Poppies in their Poppy costume and want to hear what children have to say. Teach them about the poppy program and how to spread the word where ever they go. If you don't have a Miss Poppy, it isn't to late to start. Be sure to take lots of photos and enter your Miss Poppy's scrapbook in the Dept. / National contest. One Dept. winner will be sent to National contest. Deadline for entry is April 21st.
