



WHEN IN THE DIRECT SEAT


- Overcalling at the 2 level
 - Opening Hand, 5+ Card Suit in a Major
- Overcalls at the 3 level
 - Opening Hand 6+ Cards in minor 5+ in major

IMPORTANT FEATURES TO CONSIDER

- 1) Suit Quality / Suit Length
- 2) Distribution (6-4, 5-5 Good, 5-3-3-2 BAD)
- 3) Shortness in opponent's suit
- When you are short in the opponents suit partner will have the wrong shape to balance. So whatever ranges we provide, step up the aggression when you are short in the opponent's suit.










ENTERING THE AUCTION



WHEN IN THE BALANCING SEAT

Same Range as in direct seat PLUS;

We need to be aware that any time we have shortness in the opponent's suit, partner often will have a good hand with the wrong shape to act.

We should be VERY aggressive to balance against weak two bids when we are short in their suit.








VULNERABILITY





NON – VULNERABLE


When we are non vulnerable, the risk of entering is much lower so we can get away with having a flaw or two in our hands.

VULNERABLE

When we are Vulnerable, the risk of going -200 is high. We need a good suit, preferably 6. We also would like to have good distribution. When we are short in the opponents suit, we sometimes have to just bite the bullet and get in there, even vul.

15 – 18 balanced with a stopper.



STANDARD RESPONSES TO OVERCALLS APPLY HERE.

SINGLE RAISE: 6 – 10

CUE BID: 10+ (if below 4 level)

NEW SUITS: FORCING AND NATURAL

*Be mindful when you have length in their suits. Partner is likely to be aggressive with shortness in the opponent's suit.








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
RESPONSIVE DOUBLES




The Responsive Double lets partner know it is our hand. It says, "I want to bid but do not know what to bid."


We use responsive doubles to discover major suit fits and also just to express ownership in the hand

The example auction on the left can be used whenever we have values but don't have a suit of our own to bid. We would typically have 4/5H, however sometimes we need to make this double just to tell partner we have a hand.



































































Answer Key

- 1. X We are short in spades, if we don't act it is likely partner will have a tough time. Happy to be Non-Vul
- 2. 2S We have a singleton heart. This is a super aggressive overcall but partner will have too many hearts to act
- 3. 4S The opponents have done a great job of preempting us. At least partner has short hearts.
- 4. 2H Balancing chair, we have shortness in diamonds.
- 5. Pass We have a great hand but the wrong shape to act. This is why the person who's short has to be aggressive.
- 6. 3N Ugly but they've left us no choice. See how important it is to further the preempt?
- 7. Pass Again wrong shape to act.
- 8. X Whenever its close between overcalling a minor or takeout double, choose the takeout double
- 9. X We have a diamond fit but need to bring hearts into the game. Responsive Double
- 10. 4D Splinter, if you play them. If you don't know splinters then 3D would be your bid.
- 11. 3D Transfer to hearts
- 12. 3N A Decent 8 count opposite partners 2N overcall is enough to put them in game. Partner picks 3N or 4H
- 13. X Whenever its close between overcalling a minor or takeout double, choose the takeout double
- 14. 2N Invitational, with a heart stopper or two
- 15. Pass We cant overcall a minimum opening hand with a 5 card suit vul at the 3 level
- 16. 2N Perfect 2N overcall
- 17. X Have to do what you have to do. Double doesn't promise 4 spades, just 3 of each unbid suit
- 18. 3D This is aggressive but we are the one who has a singleton spade. Partner will have too many to act.
- 19. Pass We don't have a good enough hand to go venturing to the 3 level without a fit
- 20. 3S We have an unmentioned fit and enough points to show it. DO IT
- 21. 3N We might as well give 3NT a go
- 22. 4C Tell partner we have a very good 4S bid, says nothing about having clubs controlled
- 23. Pass Wrong shape to act
- 24. 2NT Partner probably felt pressure to act because they were short. If we invite they should accept with an opening hand.
- 25. 3D Even though partner has balanced, we still have more than enough to show a good raise
- 26. X This is very aggressive but we are the ones with shortness in their suit so we need to step it up.
