



Langhorne Council for the Arts 2022 Scholarship Program/Information

In 2022, The Langhorne Council for Arts (LCA) will again award merit- and need-based scholarships to Bucks County middle and high school students (through junior year) with demonstrated talent and career interest in the arts. This includes visual and performing arts, writing, woodworking, and metalworking. A maximum of three scholarships will be awarded to students in the grades 6–8 and a maximum of three scholarships will be awarded to students in grades 9–11. Scholarship awards may be used to help fund such enrichment activities as art or music camp or private lessons with teacher of the arts. For more information: www.langhornearts.org.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicant must have a demonstrated interest and talent in at least one arts discipline and, preferably, a need for financial support.
- *These funds are not for college attendance.* Funds must be used by the applicant to take private lessons in the arts or to attend an arts enrichment program.
- Applicant must be in grades 6-11, attending a middle or high school in Bucks County, PA. Individuals are eligible to win a scholarship only once.

Application Procedure: *To be considered for a scholarship, an applicant must submit the following materials by the deadline:*

- Complete application form (including all attachments). Application available at: www.langhornearts.org.
- Typed, one-page statement *written by applicant*, addressing the following: 1) Why applicant is applying for scholarship; 2) Applicant's interest in the arts; and 3) Applicant's educational goals.
- A sample of applicant's work in the arts for panel review. Samples can be submitted via YouTube, Dropbox, PowerPoint, flash drive, email or in-person.
- At least one recommendation form completed by someone who is able to evaluate the applicant's aptitude and potential in the arts, who is not related to the applicant, and if possible, who will not benefit financially from the scholarship. - All application materials must be received by the LCA by: **5:00 pm, Saturday, March 19, 2022.** Applications will not be accepted after the deadline. Provide a self-addressed, stamped envelope if requesting return. LCA is not responsible for items left after May 7, 2022.
- Applicants can choose from the following methods to deliver their application package:

Awards: A maximum of three scholarships (\$250 each) will be awarded to students in grades 6–8. A maximum of three scholarships will be awarded to students in grades 9–11 (\$300 each with the exception of one award—the *Robert Gorgas Memorial Scholarship*—which is \$500). In accordance with scholarship policy, all checks will be paid directly to the school, organization, program, or instructor the applicant selects, and must be spent within one year of the award. **Award winners will be notified by mid-April. Scholarships will be awarded at a ceremony on May 6.** LCA Arts Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, sex, religion, or national origin.

 2. A typed, 1-page statement, *written by the applicant*, addressing the following: 1) Why applicant is applying for scholarship; 2) Applicant's interest in the arts; and 3) educational goals.
 3. At least one (1) sealed letter of reference with application.
 4. A sample of applicant's work in the arts for panel review (visual and performing arts, writing, woodworking, and metalworking). Samples can be submitted via YouTube, Dropbox, PowerPoint, flash drive, email or in-person.
 5. Submit application packages via:
