Perennial Ryegrass:

New Lawn: 5 to 6 lbs per 1,000 sq. ft. Overseeding: $2\frac{1}{2}$ to 3 lbs per 1,000 sq. ft.

Annual Ryegrass:

New Lawn: 5 to 6 lbs per 1,000 sq. ft. Overseeding: $2\frac{1}{2}$ to 3 lbs per 1,000 sq. ft.

Lawn Tips:

-Before you decide to plant grass seed, you should "work up the ground" to a depth of 3-6" -Grass seed does not need to be planted more than $\frac{1}{4}$ of inch into the soil, you do not want to bury grass seed which makes it difficult for the seed to germinate

-Rake to cover seeds with topsoil

-The most important step to remember is to keep your newly planted lawn moist-DO NOT allow the grass seed to dry out! This needs to be done until the grass seed is well established -Always have a sharp mower blade

-Raise the blade to 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 3 inches for mowing in the heat of the summer -Longer grass goes deeper into the photosynthesis process, which encourages deeper root growth -Remember that a regular lawn fertilizing program will promote a healthy lawn!
