Program Highlights

- Give back with an exchange at Cyrenians, a group who have worked with the homeless and vulnerable, for the last 50 years, to transform their lives. Their name comes from the biblical story of Simon the Cyrene, but they are a secular organization. A donation will be provided on your behalf. Visit and help at one of their sites.
- Enjoy a **bagpiping experience** at the National Piping Center.
- **Explore the highlands** on a 4x4 safari excursion with a picnic lunch.
- Attend a **demonstration with a master chocolatier** at lain Burnett The Highland Chocolatier.
