Presiding Commissioner Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner Kyle White, East District Commissioner Chet Owen and Chief Deputy Clerk Penny Gans.

Presiding Commissioner Kyle Carroll led all in prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was then said by all in attendance.

East District Commissioner Chet Owen informed the Commission of the Hundley-Whaley Field Farm & Family Day is scheduled for September 8<sup>th</sup> in Albany. Farm wagon tours and workshops begin at 5 p.m. with a meal at 7 p.m.

Chief Deputy Clerk Penny Gans presented the Commission with September 1<sup>st</sup> payroll and payables. Penny also reminded the Commission that the Courthouse will be closed Monday, September 5<sup>th</sup> for Labor Day. The Courthouse will re-open on Tuesday for normal business hours.

West District Commissioner Kyle White will be attending a Tri-County Health board meeting and signing Region D checks this week.

Sheriff Kasey Keesaman and Chief Deputy Tracy Neill met with the Commission to discuss security of the building during Country Harvest. Sheriff Keesaman reported that the DDRJ is now fully staffed and began housing offenders for Clinton County.

Road & Bridge Supervisor Bill Gray met with the Commission to review brush letters. The Commission also discussed dust complaints and the possibility of hiring another employee in the Spring.

Christy Humerickhouse of Veregy met with the Commission to give updates on the Courthouse and Sunset construction. Christy wanted to give kudos to the staff at Sunset with how well the residents are treated and cared for. Bathrooms at the Courthouse should be functional by the end of the week.

The Commission discussed and updated the historical school sign list.

Assistant Emergency Management Director Penny Gans gave an update on the storm siren project. Blue Valley Public Safety is still awaiting the delivery of transformers, which have been on backorder. Equipment has been installed in the Sheriff's Office and on the tower.

With no other business before the Commission, West District Commissioner Kyle White made the motion to adjourn until September 6, 2022. Presiding Commissioner Kyle Carroll made the second. All in favor. Motion carried.
