**First Lesson Deuteronomy 4:35-40** **35** To you it was shown, that you might know that the Lord is God; there is no other besides him.**36** Out of heaven he let you hear his voice, that he might discipline you. And on earth he let you see his great fire, and you heard his words out of the midst of the fire.**37** And because he loved your fathers and chose their offspring after them and brought you out of Egypt with his own presence, by his great power, **38** driving out before you nations greater and mightier than you, to bring you in, to give you their land for an inheritance, as it is this day, **39** know therefore today, and lay it to your heart, that the Lord is God in heaven above and on the earth beneath; there is no other.**40** Therefore you shall keep his statutes and his commandments, which I command you today, that it may go well with you and with your children after you, and that you may prolong your days in the land that the Lord your God is giving you for all time. "

**Second Lesson Galatians 3:1-9** **1** O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified.**2** Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith?**3** Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh?**4** Did you suffer so many things in vain—if indeed it was in vain?**5** Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith—**6** just as Abraham "believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"?**7** Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham.**8** And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed. "**9** So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.

**Gospel John 3:1-17** **1** Now there was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews.**2** This man came to Jesus by night and said to him, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher come from God, for no one can do these signs that you do unless God is with him. "**3** Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God. "**4** Nicodemus said to him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born? "**5** Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.**6** That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.**7** Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again. '**8** The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear its sound, but you do not know

where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit.”<sup>9</sup> Nicodemus said to him, “How can these things be?”

<sup>10</sup> Jesus answered him, “Are you the teacher of Israel and yet you do not understand these things?<sup>11</sup> Truly, truly, I say to you, we speak of what we know, and bear witness to what we have seen, but you do not receive our testimony.<sup>12</sup> If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how can you believe if I tell you heavenly things?<sup>13</sup> No one has ascended into heaven except he who descended from heaven, the Son of Man.<sup>14</sup> And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up,<sup>15</sup> that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.<sup>16</sup> “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.<sup>17</sup> For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.


