## ENTRY & PEN FEES

The pen fee is \$15 per pen, \$10 for tack pen (no bedding) which covers both days and includes set-up, pine shavings, as well as, bedding removal after the show. Pens are conveniently located next to the arena. Show pens are 6x8 and are constructed of no climb fencing and concrete flooring. There are plenty of wash stations inside the show barn. Be sure to bring a water hose. Facility is enclosed.

## HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Any goat exhibiting signs of infectious disease or symptoms of illness will not be permitted the show grounds. This determination will be at the discretion of the show superintendent. Registered goats with a registration tattoo number accompanied by registration papers and a Scrapie Eradication Program premise identification number **do not require a Scrapie ear tag**. Intrastate goats must have a registration certificate, a registration tattoo number and a Scrapie Premise ID number.

## SHOW RULES

Miniature Silky Fainting Goat Association rules shall govern this show. Refer to the MSFGA website [www.msfgaregistry.org](http://www.msfgaregistry.org) for complete show rules. All goats entered in the shows must be registered with the MSFGA. Over height animals will not be permitted to compete in the shows. Does must not exceed 23.5" at the withers and bucks must not exceed 25" at the withers. All animals will be measured by an official measurement committee.

## ARRIVAL/CHECK IN

Goats may arrive any time after 10 AM on Wednesday, October 16th. All goats must be checked in and measured by Friday 8:00AM.

## RV PARKING

RV parking is \$30 per night, includes electricity and water. (Please pay Terri Randolph) A clean shower facility is available inside the barn.

## PARKING

There will be a \$5 parking fee per day per vehicle. An In & Out pass will be provided for each exhibitor.

## FOOD

Unfortunately, this venue will not allow the Yellow Rose committee to bring in any food/beverages. However, there will be concessions available on the show grounds.

## AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded first through fourth place in all regular classes. Rosettes will be presented to Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion and Best Wether in Show. Rosettes and special trophies will be presented to Best in Show.
