Regular Monthly Meeting

Salute to the Flag: Regular meeting call to order:

Vice Chairman Scott Guzic, Supervisor Raymond Guzic, Jr., and Solicitor Thomas Swope Chairman Martin Craine was unavoidably detained.

Kim Wells representing Leewards owners of the Allegheny Ridge Wind Farm, Kristian Baudoux representing Mainline Newspapers Ronald Muldoon representing the Lilly-Washington Community Center also attended the meeting.

Public Participation:

As discussed:

<u>Kim Wells</u>- Representing Leeward Renewable Energy and the Allegheny Ridge Wind Farm- to discuss with the Supervisors of a plan to repower several turbines in Washington Township. Turbines would be updated to 2.2 Mega Watt from 2.0 Mega Watt, blade length to increase from 87 meters (286 feet) to 110 meters (361 feet). Setbacks will need to be implemented to accommodate the longer blade length.

The nacelles will need to be updated, and the underground collection lines will need to be restructured, an amendment to the Access Maintenance Agreement procured, and permitting through the Laurel Municipal Inspection Agency and the increased pricing for the Decommissioning Agreement.

Time frame is to get all permitting and agreements in place by end of 2025 with the repowering project to begin in Fall of 2026.

<u>Ronald Muldoon</u>-Facilities Manager for the Community Hall and the Lilly/ Washington Public Library. Expressed concerns about the electronic locking mechanism for the facility. If there is a daytime emergency between operating hours, the doors are manually locked. The next morning the electronic lock is disabled due to the manual lock on the door. Supervisors will decide on the actions to remedy the situation, most likely with a keypad lock.
