ORDINANCE NUMBER 509

An ordinance amending ordinance ^{number} 1. 464 and repealing Section 25 of said ordinance ^{number} 1. 464.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Garnett, Kansas:

Section 1. 1. That section 25 of ordinance ^{number} 1. 464, an ordinance concerning the water works of the City of Garnett, Kansas, regulating and governing the same, establishing, use, rates, rules and regulations for the government of water consumers, passed by the City Council the 27th day of December, 1909, and approved by the Mayor December 29th, 1909, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

The following is established as a tariff of water rates to the consumer from the waterworks of the City of Garnett, Kansas:

RATES.

- Blacksmith shops, first fire, \$3.00, each additional fire 50¢ per annum.
- Churches, free.
- Dwelling houses, four rooms or less, one family, \$4.00 per annum.
- Five room house, \$5.00 per annum, each additional room 50¢ per room; each additional family $\frac{1}{2}$ rates.
- Filling private cisterns, furnishing water, 6¢ per barrel.
- Meat markets, \$5.00 per annum.
- Offices \$5.00 per annum.
- Private stables, including washing carriages, one horse, \$2.50 per annum; two horses, \$4.00 per annum, each additional horse, \$1.00 per annum. Each cow, \$1.50 per annum.
- Stores, first faucet, \$5.00 per annum, each additional faucet, \$5.00 per annum.
- Restaurants, \$10.00 to \$20.00 per annum.
- Building purposes-- For brick work, 10,000 brick or less, \$1.00; for brick over 10,000, per 1,000, 5¢; for perch of stone, (16 1/2 cu. ft.) 5¢; for plastering 300 square yards or less, \$1.00

ALL OTHER PURPOSES, METER RATES.

Meter Rates.

\$1.00 for each quarter, if 3,000 gallons or less are used, if over that amount per quarter is used, then the following table or rates, shall apply and be payable monthly:

The rate per month shall be, for first 1,000 gallons.....33 1/3

When 1,000 gallons are used, each additional 1,000 gallons or fractions thereof, until 5,000 gallons are used.....30¢

When 5,000 gallons are used, each additional 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof, until 10,000 gallons are used.....25¢

When 10,000 gallons are used, each additional 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof, until 20,000 gallons are used.....20¢

When 20,000 gallons are used, each additional 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof, until 30,000 gallons are used.....15¢

When 30,000 gallons are used, each additional 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof, until 50,000 gallons are used.....12¢

When 50,000 gallons are used, each additional 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof, until 100,000 gallons are used.....10¢

When 100,000 gallons are used, each additional 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof, until 500,000 gallons are used..... 8¢

When 500,000 gallons are used, each additional 1,000 gallons..... 6¢

Section No. 2. That Section 25 of ordinance ^{number} No. 464 is hereby repealed.

Section No. 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the City Council, approval by the Mayor and publication in the official city paper.
