

# NET NEUTRALITY

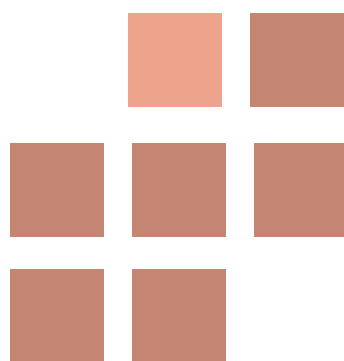
## 1. NO BLOCKING

ISPs should not be permitted to block access to legal websites, applications, services.



## 2. NO DISCRIMINATION

ISPs shall not favor their affiliated content providers or discriminate against particular Internet services based on the identity of the user, information content, or the type of service being provided.



## 3. NO PAID PRIORITIZATION

ISPs should not be permitted to sell prioritized transmission to certain content, applications, and service providers over other Internet traffic sharing the same network facilities.



## 4. REASONABLE NETWORK MANAGEMENT

ISPs should be able to engage in reasonable network management to address issues such as congestion, viruses, and spam as long as such actions are consistent with these principles in a content-neutral manner.



## 5. RESPONSIBLE SELF-REGULATION

ISPs should establish an independent, industry self-regulatory regime that meets approval of federal regulators.
