
Our monthly meeting will be the same day (May 20th) as the Tune Up Clinic and also hosted by the Martins.

I went up to the Fort Lee Historic Park this morning to see the space shuttle fly into NYC aboard NASA's 747 shuttle carrier. It was an amazing sight! The plane flew quite low and slow past the George Washington Bridge and loudly went up the Hudson as far as the Tappan Zee Bridge and then back down again passing the Intrepid and the Statute of Liberty and landing at JFK airport. It will be brought by barge to the aircraft carrier Intrepid in June.
