The past few writings the Lord gave me all dealt with one sub theme, order. Have you ever paid close attention to the beginning of the Bible?

Genesis 1:1-2 - In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

I don't know about you but before I came to Jesus (and even a bit after accepting Him in my heart) I was chaotic, orderless, and unorganized (spiritually speaking). I did what I wanted without caring about the consequences. God had a plan for me (as He does for you and those around us). He never gave up. Do you know what the first command and act of obedience is in the Bible?

Genesis 1:3 - Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

I remember the day I gave my heart to the Lord. My life was so out of order. I was diagnosed with major depression and general anxiety disorder a time before. At that moment I was an out-patient of a mental institution because I felt extremely lost and confused. The hospital didn't believe I was a serious threat to myself or others but they did agree I needed some kind of help. I would go to the hospital during the day but I was allowed to go home after the group sessions.

One of the days after coming home, I turned on my television and a well known female "televangelist" was on (not the one most of you are thinking of). She was telling her story and how God turned her around. She was saying something I had not heard (at that time) anyone say of the Lord. She said He can miraculously change lives if we allow

Him in our hearts. The catcher for me was that she said He loves us unconditionally. He wants to be with us because of His great love for us. I had never heard anyone say that before. I stood up with tears streaming from my eyes. No one was around me. I was home all alone. I lifted my hands (which I had never done) and asked the Lord to forgive me of all my wrongs; to come into my heart; to show me His love.

God can, has, and will create something out of what seems to be nothing. It took some time for me. Yet ten years later I am writing my experiences and sharing what Holy Spirit gives me in the hope that all of us fully allow the Lord to overtake and overwhelm us by His Spirit.
