Most recently, you received a copy of my letter to OMB Director Russell Vought, Subj: Recommendations to Improve Program/Project Management and Achieve the *President's Management Agenda* (PMA) dated October 27.

Please forward the Vought letter (attached) to the future OMB Director and Secretary of Defense. It addresses elements of the current PMA that should be included in Pres. Biden's future agenda as well my specific recommendations regarding PMA objectives to:
