## STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE

RE: ASSISTING OR ADMINISTERING MPD APPROVED MEDICATIONS OR SUBSTANCES

**DATE:** March 14, 2003 (Supercedes January 2, 2003)

**EMTB, IV and Airway Technicians** - In accordance with the Washington State, Department of Health, EMTB, Intravenous Therapy Technician, and Airway Technician Field Protocols, personnel should consult **on-line medical control** before assisting with or administering the following medications or substances per protocol:

## ACTIVATED CHARCOAL METERED DOSE INHALER

NITROGLYCERIN SYRUP OF IPECAC

**OXYGEN, ORAL GLUCOSE, EPINEPHRINE AUTO INJECTOR, and ASPIRIN** may be administered **per off-line medical control** in accordance with the Washington State, Department of Health, and Kittitas County, Basic Life Support Field Protocols.

**First Responder** - In accordance with the Washington State, Department of Health, First Responder Field Protocols, First Responders may administer per <u>off-line medical control</u> the following medication <u>only</u> per protocol: **OXYGEN** 

<u>Intermediate Life Support Technicians</u> – In accordance with the Washington State, Department of Health, ILS Technician Field Protocols, personnel should consult <u>on-line medical control</u> before assisting with or administering the following medications:

## ALBUTEROL NALOXONE NITROGLYCERIN

<u>On-line Medical Control</u>: Consulting emergency department physician for patient care direction. Medical advice may be received from the paramedic in route to the scene for assisting or administering the above listed medications or substances if provider is unable to make contact with emergency department.

<u>Off-line Medical Control:</u> Medical Program Director approved written Patient Care Protocol or Standard Operating Procedure.
