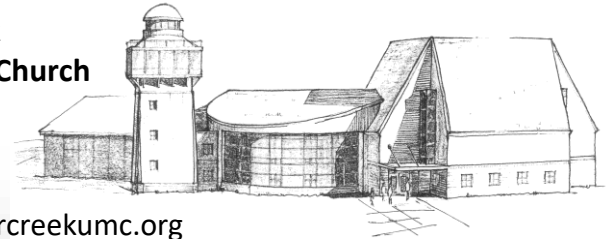
Fall Schedules
