I hope you have enjoyed your summer and looking forward to getting "back into action" with Ebell.

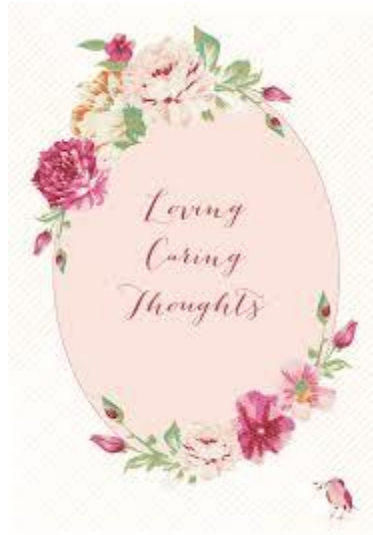
I have enjoyed my summer being lazy and watching my kitten grow but look forward to seeing all of you at the meeting.
