

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO**  
**Ordinance O-2015-29**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH ARAB TERMITE & PEST CONTROL, INC., FOR PEST CONTROL SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, The Village is in need of termite control services for its property at 119 W. Main Street; and

**WHEREAS**, Arab Termite & Pest Control, Inc. is willing and able to provide termite control services as needed and requested by the Village; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Ohio that:

**SECTION I:** Village Council accepts the recommendation of the Mayor that the Village contract with Arab Termite & Pest Control, Inc. for termite control services at a cost of \$952.00 for the installation of the Sentricon Colony Elimination System and an annual renewal fee of \$225.00, which may be adjusted in future years.

**SECTION II:** The Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Village to secure the necessary termite control services from Arab Termite & Pest Control, Inc., substantially in form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

**SECTION IV:** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to approve this at the earliest possible time, in order to acquire termite control services for the Village to protect the property at 119 W. Main Street. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, the ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**SECTION V:** Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

MR. DICKERSON moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.

MR. CAMPBELL seconded the motion.
