

**TOWN OF LINCOLN  
TOWN BOARD MEETING  
March 11, 2026**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Headson at 6:00 pm. Present were: Jason Headson, Lynne Black, Tressa Votis and Diane Dubey. Also, present was: David Derozier.

On a motion by Black, second by Votis and all in favor, the agenda for the evening was approved.

The pledge of allegiance was recited.

On a motion by Black, second by Votis and all in favor, the consent agenda was approved including minutes of the

- February 11, 2026 Minutes
- Vouchers/Payrolls

Jason stated that Wabeno will be utilizing the Local Small Structures Improvement Program money for bridge work and there will not be funding available for the Town.

Jason presented the following quotes for the Metonga Rip Rap Project:

Outdoor Rooms	\$84,850
NextGen Construction	\$39,000
Northern Dreamscapes	\$38,325
Midwest Precision	\$31,230
Integrity Landscaping	\$44,440

He stated that up to 50% of the costs would be reimbursed from the grant. Discussion ensued. On a motion by Votis, second by Black and all in favor, it was approved to accept the quote from Midwest Precision in the amount of \$31,230 for the Metonga Rip Rap Project.

Diane inquired about food provisions for the Town elections. Discussion ensued. On a motion by Votis, second by Black and all in favor, it was approved to allow \$50 provision for food for the April 7, 2026 election.

Jason discussed the resignation letter received from Diane. Diane stated that due to difficulty with other commitments and family health issues, she would need to step back from the Clerk/Treasurer position effective June 30<sup>th</sup> or earlier if the position is filled, but would be willing to return to the Deputy position. Discussion ensued regarding splitting the two positions but the Board chose to keep it as one. Tressa stated that she would post the positions on Facebook and in the Forest Republican and would accept applications through April 6, 2026. On a motion by Votis, second by Black and all in favor, it was approved to accept the resignation letter from Diane.

Diane presented the treasurer's report.
