Misleading Finals

UNLV (+4) lost at Boise State 21-7. However, UNLV was only outgained 373-327 and actually had the rushing edge at 217-215. UNLV had a 48-yard FG doink off the cross-bar. On two different drives in the second half, they had a first and goal at the Boise State 5-yard line and also the Boise State 8-yard line and came away with a combined ZERO points.

Penn State (+3) lost to Oregon 45-37. Penn State did have a 523-469 yard edge including 297-186 on the ground (8.7-4.5 in yards per carry). Penn State was -2 in TO's including an interception that set up a 1-yard Oregon TD "drive". The Nittany Lions also missed a 40-yard field goal.

Texas (-3) lost to Georgia 22-19 in overtime. Texas had a 389-277 yard edge for the game. It was 6-6 at halftime despite the fact Texas had a 260-54 yard edge at that point. The Longhorns had 3 turnovers and also missed 2 FG's.

Games in Rotation Order

Saturday, December 14th

Salute To Veterans Bowl - Crampton Bowl - Montgomery, AL

† **South Alabama 31 Western Michigan 24.** Our power ratings make this game South Alabama by 10.6 which is close to what the line opened at (USA -10). The Jags played a tougher schedule and were +0.9 in yards per play margin while Western Michigan was -0.2 in ypp margin. So why are we not recommending South Alabama as a big play here? Well, it's bowl season and there are a lot of injuries, opt outs and transfers. South Alabama QB Gio Lopez left the Jag's regular season finale late in the game with an injury. If he can't go, Bishop Davenport will get the start. They also lost leading rusher Fluff Bothwell to the transfer portal. WMU saw their starting TE and a couple of starters on the DL hit the portal. We haven't bet the game yet but lean UNDER.

† **Army 21 Navy 17.** @Northwest Stadium in Landover, MD. The 125th meeting between the two with Navy holding a 62-55-7 series edge. Navy famously won 14 straight from 2002-2015 but Army has taken the last two in dramatic fashion. The Black Knights won 20-17 in double OT in 2022 and then last year won 17-11 as they stopped Navy at the goal line in the final seconds. Navy does have the situational edge coming off a bye and have only played once since November 16th. Meanwhile, Army has played Notre Dame, UTSA and last week's AAC Championship game vs Tulane in the last 3 weeks. Army is the better team with +1.0 ypp and +100 ypg margins while Navy has actually been outgained by 5 ypg this season. Navy QB Blake Horvath should play here after being dinged up the last couple of games. The UNDER is on a 16-1-1 run in this series. The only game that went OVER was a couple of years because the game went to double OT and then last year's game pushed the lowest totals' line in series history (28). The two teams have combined for 38 points or less in each of the last 10 meetings. We bet UNDER early in the week but prefer Navy at current.

Celebration Bowl - Mercedes-Benz Stadium - Atlanta, GA

† **Jackson State 28 South Carolina State 27.** The Celebration Bowl is comprised of the champions of the SWAC vs the champions of the MEAC - the two prominent conferences of historically black colleges and universities (HBCUs) in Division I. The MEAC Champs are 6-2 in this bowl. SC State is making their first appearance since they won it in 2021 over Jackson State. The two teams are evenly matched as Jackson State is +1.9 in ypp margin and +123 in ypg margin while South Carolina State is +1.6 in ypp margin and +132 in ypg margin. SC State played the tougher schedule. SC State is coached by Chennis Berry in his first season while Jackson St is coached by 2nd year TC Taylor. We bet SC State +3.5 on the open and would still lean that way.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Tuesday, December 17th

Frisco Bowl - Toyota Stadium - Frisco, TX

† **Memphis 31 West Virginia 27.** West Virginia fired their head coach Neal Brown and OC Chad Scott will serve as the interim here. West Virginia was a banged up team down the stretch especially at WR and in the secondary. Their top LB Josiah Trotter did enter the transfer portal. As of Wednesday, December 11th at Noon ET, Memphis hasn't had any major opt outs or transfers. They appear to be locked in. That's certainly what they were in their last game as they upset Tulane 34-24 as 13-point underdogs. It was their best performance of the season. The Tigers are the better team statistically as they are +0.4 in ypp margin and +87 in ypg margin. Meanwhile, WVU -0.6 ypp and -17 ypg although they did play a much tougher schedule. We usually like to fade interim coaches now in bowl games and bet Memphis.

Wednesday, December 18th

Boca Raton Bowl - FAU Stadium - Boca Raton, FL

† **James Madison 30 Western Kentucky 23.** James Madison QB Alonza Barnett will miss the bowl game with an injury and Billy Atkins is expected to start. Their leading tackler Jacob Dobbs is also questionable here due to injury and their starting LT hit the portal. If you think that's bad, WKU has seen nine starters hit the transfer portal including starting QB Caden Veltkamp. However, it should be noted that in the past WKU transfer portal players have still played in bowl games under Tyson Helton. JMU is the much better team with +1.1 ypp and +87 ypg margins vs WKU's -0.2 ypp and -20 ypg margins. They played similar strength of schedules. If most of the WKU transfer portal players don't play, we like JMU, if most of the WKU transfer portal players do play, we like WKU. We'll know a lot more in 5 days or so.

LA Bowl - Sofi Stadium - Inglewood, CA

† **California 27 UNLV 24.** UNLV head coach Barry Odom has taken the Purdue job and WR coach Del Alexander will serve as the interim coach here. OC Brennan Marion is also expected to leave prior to the bowl. Just before we went to press on Wednesday, December 11th, Cal QB Fernando Mendoza entered the transfer portal. Cal is also down their starting LT due to injury while a starting LG is questionable. Their leading WR Nzayah Hunter is in the portal, along with an interior OL. UNLV is expected to have many transfers and opt outs but only starting CB Tony Grimes has hit the portal so far. UNLV was the better team in the stats at +1.2 in ypp margin and +75 in ypg margin. Meanwhile Cal was +0.6 in ypp and +42 in ypg. Cal did play the tougher schedule. We originally thought Cal would be one of our stronger bowl plays of the season as UNLV should be flat after losing their big game to Boise and their head coach. But with no starting QB, we only lean Cal now.

Betting CFB Openers (Note I have bet both sides/totals to a few games due to injury and opt outs)

Every Sunday in Vegas at 11am PT, Circa Sports is the first book in the world to release CFB lines and we bet them every week. We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). Last year we were 405-358-6 (53.4%, CLV 577-137-55 +2.09 ppg). Below is some of what we bet already. Starting last season, Fan Duel and Draft Kings have been releasing select CFB games a couple hours before Circa so those bets are included below as well. All bets are either \$550 at Fan Duel, Draft Kings, Westgate and South Point or \$1100 at Circa unless otherwise noted.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, December 12th

SAN FRANCISCO 27 L.A. Rams 23. The 49ers come in off arguably their best performance of the season as they destroyed the Bears 38-13 as 3-point home favorites. The 49ers had a dominant 7.4-3.1 ypp edge and rank No. 2 in the NFL in ypp margin (+1.3). The Rams are also off their best win of the season upsetting the Bills 44-42 as 3.5-point home underdogs. SF has won 9 of the last 12 in the series but did lose 27-24 to the Rams in the earlier meeting this year. Whoever wins probably becomes a "play-on" team down the stretch of the season.

Sunday, December 15th

WASHINGTON 26 New Orleans 17. The Commanders come in off a late-season bye. They are No. 8 in ypp margin (+0.4) and in the thick of the playoffs while the Saints are No. 24 in ypp margin (-0.4) and playing with an interim. On top of that, Saints QB Derek Carr broke his hand and is unlikely to play here. Jake Haener probably gets the start. We lean Washington.

HOUSTON 27 Miami 23. Miami is still in the playoff mix thanks to last week's 32-26 OT win over the Jets. They're taking on a Houston team that leads the AFC South and the Texans are off a bye. Houston is the better team in the stats and in the better spot. We like them especially if you can find a -2.5 -120 in the market. We prefer the OVER though because you're getting value with the games Tua didn't start being accounted for in the full-season stats.

N.Y. Jets 21 JACKSONVILLE 18. N.Y. Jets QB Aaron Rodgers had his first 300-yard passing game in 3 years last week but it still wasn't enough to get the Jets a win. They are 1-9 SU and 2-8 ATS in their last 10 games. Statistically, they are +0.1 in ypp margin so hence why they still get bet in the market by some of the pros. Jacksonville is also 3-10 SU on the season but the Jags are 5-1-1 ATS in their last 7 and pulled the upset over Tennessee last week without QB Lawrence. We can't lay more than a FG on the road with a bad team. Lean JAX.

Cincinnati 26 TENNESSEE 21. Cincinnati is playing back-to-back games on the road and is coming off a short week. They got the fortunate win over Dallas last week thanks to a special teams gaffe. Statistically, the Bengals are better than their 5-8 record (+0.2 in ypp margin) but so are the Titans (+0.0 in ypp margin). The problem is the Titans are easily the worst team in the NFL where it counts most: your wallet as they are 2-11 ATS. **Baltimore 28 N.Y. GIANTS 14.** This is the largest point spread in the NFL this season. The Ravens come in off the bye and rank No. 1 in the NFL in ypp margin (+1.4) despite a 8-5 record. Meanwhile, the Giants are just playing out a miserable season with a back-up QB. They did cover for the first time in 8 games last week in their 14-11 loss to the Saints. With that being said, we can't get to this spread especially on the road.

Kansas City 24 CLEVELAND 21. How much longer can the Chiefs keep this up? It's one of the most miraculous runs in NFL history as they have now won 15 straight one-possession games dating back to last season. Last week it was the "doink for the division" in their 19-17 last second win over the Chargers. However, the Chiefs are -0.2 in ypp margin which indicates a below-average team and KC has failed to cover the spread in 7 straight games. We'd love to bet against them big this week but they're playing the pathetic Browns who are No. 31 in ypp margin and just 4-9 ATS.

CAROLINA 23 Dallas 20. Carolina has been playing really well as of late with 5 straight covers including last week in a 22-16 loss to the Eagles as 2-TD dogs. The problem is now they are playing with expectation as this is the first time they have been favored this season. It is deserved as they are better in ypp margin and get Dallas traveling on a short week. The Cowboys brought back memories of "Leon Lett" last week with their special teams blunder vs the Bengals. We think Carolina is the right side, but it is tough laying points with bad teams.

PHILADELPHIA 25 Pittsburgh 19. Big time out of conference game here between two red-hot teams. The Steelers are 10-3 SU and ATS this season far exceeding their preseason expectations of a possible losing season. Statistically though, they are -0.1 in ypp margin. Meanwhile, the Eagles are 11-2 SU and 8-5 ATS and have won 9 straight. They have been statistically more impressive with a +1.1 ypp margin. Money has come in on Philly in the last 24 hours and we agree. We also lean OVER. **Buffalo 28 DETROIT 27.** Another incredible out of conference matchup in what should be the best "4 o'clock" window of the NFL season. The Bills are coming off a loss to the Rams and traveling again. Meanwhile the Lions do have extra rest after beating Green Bay last Thursday in the final seconds. Detroit converted 4 out of 5 4th down attempts and won a franchise-record 11th straight game. They are playing a 9th straight week while Buffalo just had a bye a few weeks ago. We'll call for the outright upset with Buffalo QB Allen taking advantage of a banged-up Lions D.

DENVER 25 Indianapolis 20. Both teams come in off a bye. The Broncos have been arguably the biggest surprise team in the NFL this season at 10-3 ATS and would be the No. 7 seed if the playoffs started today. Not bad for a team that had a 5.5-win total. The Colts are 6-7 and desperately need a win here to remain in the playoff hunt. Denver is better in the stats (+0.3 vs -0.3 in ypp margin) but Indianapolis has played the tougher schedule. Despite the early week money on Indy, we lean DEN.

L.A. CHARGERS 24 Tampa Bay 21. Both teams have exceeded expectations so far this season especially the Chargers who are 9-3-1 ATS. Tampa Bay is better in the stat (+0.4 vs +0.1 in ypp margin) and neither team has played that tough of a schedule. Tampa has won 3 straight games but they've come against the bottom 5 teams in the NFL. They're taking a step up in class here vs a Chargers team that will want to atone for a tough loss vs the Chiefs last week.

ARIZONA 26 New England 19. New England comes in off a bye. The Patriots had been playing better as of late with a 4-2 ATS mark but still sit at 2-10 SU in their last 12 games. Arizona has played the toughest schedule in the NFL and have a +0.4 ypp margin compared to NE's -0.8 ypp margin (No. 27). We lean Arizona here.

Green Bay 24 SEATTLE 21. A great matchup for playoff positioning in the NFC. If the season ended today, these two would be playing each other in the playoffs with the Seahawks the No. 3 seed and the Packers the No. 6 seed. Green Bay is the better team in the stats with a +1.0 ypp margin (No. 4) despite playing one of the toughest schedules in the NFL. Seattle is +0.1 in ypp margin despite playing an average strength of schedule. The Seahawks are playing their best ball with a young staff. They are 4-0 SU and ATS since their bye. We want to bet Green Bay but not at this number.

Monday, December 16th

MINNESOTA 26 Chicago 17. Minnesota is remarkably 11-2 on the season and along with Denver are the biggest surprise in the NFL as their win total was only 6.5 in the summer. They are +0.5 in ypp margin but haven't played the most difficult schedule. Usually, teams get a one-game bump with an interim coach. Chicago is not one of those teams as they were dismantled by the 49ers last week. The Bears are now dead-last in ypp margin (-1.4). Minnesota's schedule is about to get a lot tougher with Seattle, Green Bay and Detroit on deck but they should get another comfortable win here.

Atlanta 25 LAS VEGAS 20. Atlanta should be better than their 6-7 record as they are +0.2 in ypp margin. However, QB Cousins continues to have TO issues as last week was a horrible effort in his return to Minnesota (0-2 ratio). That was the Falcons 4th straight loss which has put them on the outside looking in when it comes to the NFC South and the playoffs. The good news is they get a Raiders team that has lost 9 straight games.
