

Discover the Outer Banks of North Carolina

September 20 - 24, 2020

5 Days, 4 Nights

Sunday ♦ Travel Day

After a day of travel, we'll arrive at the beautiful Hampton Suites Inn and settle in before departing for dinner at Mike Dianna's Grille Room in the village of Corolla, NC. Historic Corolla is home to some quaint shops and museums and a well-stocked bookstore. Enjoy some downtime on your own on your first evening in the Outer Banks. (D)

Monday ♦ Corolla/Kitty Hawk

This morning we'll enjoy a leisurely breakfast at the hotel before meeting our local guide. Then we're off to an open air pony tour in Corolla where our guide will entertain us with local lore, legends and the ecology of the Outer Banks. We might see surfing dolphin, deer and boar. We'll get up close to the native ponies that roam freely across the beaches. Did someone say photo op?

Next, we'll stop at Harris Teeters and bring back lunch to eat pool side at the hotel or on the beach. The rest of the afternoon is yours to enjoy! Dinner this evening will be served oceanfront at The Black Pelican Restaurant in Kitty Hawk, NC. (B, D)

Tuesday ♦ Duck/Kill Devil Hills

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll depart with our guide for the Currituck Lighthouse and tour the historic Whalehead Club & Exhibit Gallery and the Outer Banks Center for Wildlife Education. We'll stop for lunch in the quaint town of Duck, NC and spend some time browsing at the popular Scarborough Faire shops.

Later, you may choose to stroll along the Duck Boardwalk, the perfect place to enjoy the natural beauty of the Outer Banks. Walking trails meander through 11 acres of forest, swamp, open green spaces and the gorgeous Currituck Sound. Or spend the rest of the afternoon on your own by the pool or on the beach. We'll have dinner at the All-You-Can-Eat Buffet at Captain George's in Kill Devil Hills. (B, D)

Wednesday ♦ Kill Devil Hills / Manteo

We'll depart this morning after breakfast for Kill Devil Hills to visit the Wright Brothers National Memorial. A 60-foot granite monument stands at the entrance to the National Park, which marks the successful launching and landing points of the brothers' first attempt at flight over the dunes at Kitty Hawk in 1900. Enjoy lunch and shopping on your own along the waterfront in beautiful downtown Manteo, NC.

Later, we'll visit Roanoke Island Festival Park, the Adventure Museum and Outdoor Living Museum on the site of the 16th century settlement of Roanoke. We'll learn about the lives of the early settlers on Roanoke Island and tour the Elizabeth II, a small wooden vessel where the guides are dressed in period costumes. The Roanoke Island Aquarium offers a variety of underwater life and an impressive gift shop. A fabulous dinner awaits us this evening at Pamlico Jack's in Nag's Head. (B, D)

Thursday ♦ Travel Home

After breakfast, we'll depart for home with many fond memories and new friends. (B)
