



LITTLE AL'S MINI GOLF COVID-19 RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PLAYERS

If you wish to play mini golf, please remember that you play at your own risk. With that in mind, if you choose to play, we strongly suggest you follow these recommendations:

BEFORE YOU PLAY

- It is recommended that you play only with family members, persons living in your household, or individuals you believe to be low risk.
- Do not play if you or your playing partner(s):
 - Exhibit any COVID-19 symptoms, such as a fever, cough, sore throat, difficulty breathing, or other symptoms identified by health experts.
 - Have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- Tournament play is not allowed.

PREPARING TO PLAY

- Wash your hands with disinfectant soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or use hand sanitizer, before starting your game.
- Bring hand sanitizer and use it before you begin play, between games, and again when you have completed play and leave the course.
- If possible, use your own pencil or pen to record your score.
- Do not share any of your equipment (including your putter or golf ball) with others.
- If you cough or sneeze, do so in a tissue or in your sleeve.

WHILE PLAYING

- Keep a 2-metre distance from other players.
- Do not touch the flag pins – the ball is considered in the hole when it touches the flag pin.
- Avoid all physical contact (including shaking hands) with other players.
- Players must pick up/touch only their own golf ball.
- Avoid touching surfaces throughout the course - particularly high contact surfaces like door handles, gates, the flag pins, signs, animal sculptures, bridge railings, and fences.
- If you touch something, make sure to wash your hands and disinfect the surface you have touched.
- Avoid touching your face after touching a golf ball or any surface.
- Use only the sanitized golf ball and putter you receive, and change to another freshly sanitized golf ball and club after each game.
- If your sanitized golf ball enters the water, ask the attendant for a replacement ball.

AFTER PLAYING

- Return your putter to the designated bucket located at the window of the starter shack.
- Do not return your pencil or scorecard – keep them or dispose of them in a waste receptacle.
- Wash your hands carefully with water and disinfectant soap or with hand sanitizer.
- Leave the course immediately after you finish playing.
- Do not gather in groups after play.
- Do not go to (or stay at) the course to watch others play.
