RULES, REGULATIONS & DIVISION REQUIREMENTS

1. Helmets are REQUIRED for all riders, without exception. If you are on a horse, you must wear a helmet. Western riders will not be penalized for wearing English helmets.
2. Riders must be neatly and appropriately attired. Boots must have heels.
3. Show management reserves the right to alter, divide, cancel, combine, or relocate classes to expedite the show. All management decisions are final. No one shall approach the judge without direct permission from show manager!
4. ALL HORSES ON GRANGE PROPERTY MUST PRESENT AN ORIGINAL 2017 COGGINS TEST – no exceptions! Coggins must be presented at time of entry.
5. Entry fee is \$10/class. No refunds will be issued once the preceding class is being judged.
6. Riders under age 18 must have a parent/guardian sign the entry form & assume all responsibility for the minor(s).
7. Open Checks: you must close the check by the end of the show or a \$5 handling fee will be added.
8. Both rings will run simultaneously – cross-enter at your own risk. Classes will be held for 2 minutes only and no refunds will be issued if you miss your class due to a cross-entry!
9. 1st-6th place ribbons will be awarded in each class, along with a division champion and reserve champion determined by number of points earned in division. Management's decision regarding tiebreakers are final.
10. Any damage done to Grange property, accidental or intentional, by any spectator, horse, rider, owner, family member or affiliate, will be the responsibility of that party to compensate.
11. Inclement weather and poor footing are major concerns of management. In the event of rain the day prior to or on the day of a show, please call 215.932.4408 at regular intervals to check on show status."
12. GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP is mandatory. If any incidence of poor sportsmanship, from any rider, trainer, family member, or affiliate is observed by management, that party will be asked to leave immediately. You will be scratched from all remaining classes and no refunds will be issued – no exceptions.

DIVISION REQUIREMENTS

1. For any age-specific division: age determined by date of show.
2. Speed Classes marked as "Youth" are open to riders age 12 and under only. Jr. Speed classes are for riders age 13-18. Sr. Speed classes age 19 and up. Speed division riders may use English or Western tack. Champion/Reserve awarded to overall high point Youth, Junior, and Senior riders.
3. Lead Line division open to riders age 6 and under, and riders may not enter other classes. Rider must be 6 years old or under. SHOW WILL NOT STOP TO HOLD LEAD LINE – see rule 8 above.
4. Short Stirrup open to riders under age 10. For class #45, riders may choose ground rails OR x-rails, and will be judged together.
5. Jr. English division open to riders age 15 and under, Sr. English open to riders age 16 and up. Open Equitation is open to riders of all ages. Riders entered in Open Equitation may not enter the 2' divisions.
6. Test classes (marked with **) will be asked to perform a test at the judge's discretion. Copies of the possible tests list are available upon request for both Western and English exhibitors.
7. Trail Classes (marked with *) will be held in designated area at discretion of management. Points will count towards their respective pleasure divisions.
8. Beginner English (31-34) and Intermediate English (35-38) are for riders age 15 and under.
9. Long Stirrup (74-76) is for riders age 16 and up.
10. Green Hunter (66-69) division is open to horses in their 1st or 2nd years of showing only.
11. Acclimation Flat & Fences (classes 40, 41) are designed to give horse and rider a "warm up" in a judged format. Flat will run walk-trot-canter both ways of the ring. Fences will be over 8 cross-rails. Judged on general presentation.
