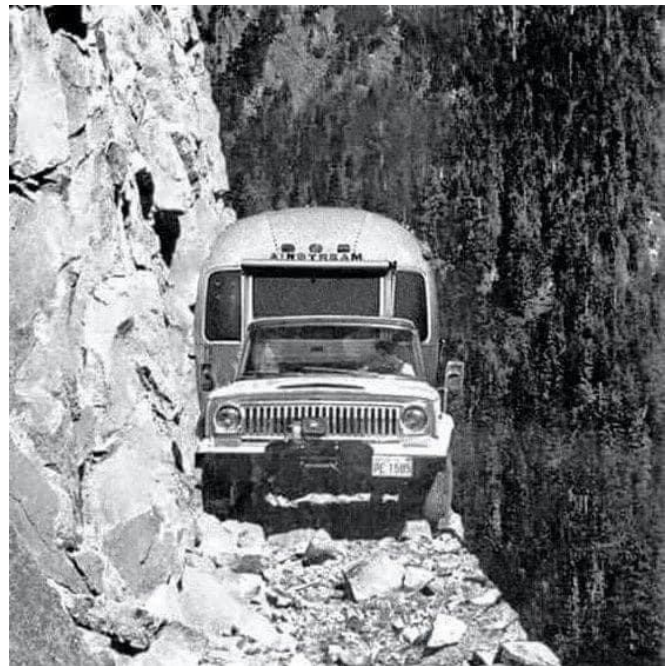


## **ANASAZI's On The Road...**
