
The Bible's Wisdom of the Beginnings Series: The First Story

## Day Six: Part 1



(1:24) Elohim said, "The Dry Land shall cause to bring forth a living soul from her according to their kinds; large animals, smaller moving animals, and wild animals, according to their kinds." And it was so.

<sup>(1:25)</sup> Elohim made the wild animals of the Dry Land according to their kind, large animals according to their kind, and every small moving animal of the ground according to his kind. And Elohim saw that it was Tov.

The sixth day corresponds with the third day. On the third day the Dry Land brought forth vegetation and fruit trees. On the sixth day the Dry Land brought forth living souls for creatures with appetites, longings, and desires linked to those things. The lights in the Skies are also providing light for both of them.

- An interesting point to note is animals, like plants and trees, "reproduce their own kinds," but neither were blessed by Elohim like He blessed the water and flying creatures "*be fruitful and multiply*."
- Another important point to keep in mind for the future is "small moving animals" are "of the <u>ground</u>," not "of the <u>Dry Land</u>." The Hebrew word for ground is "<u>adamah</u>."

The sixth day and the third day are alike in another way. Two different types of things were made on the same day. On the third day, Dry Land and Seas were made first, then plants and trees followed. On the sixth day, the animals have been created, and something different will be created next. *Can you guess what that could be?*
