Behavior Interventionist Description:

We are currently hiring full-time and/or part-time Behavior Interventionists at all of our centers to work with our clients, children with ASD, both in the home and at the center. JAC prides itself on providing each staff member with quality clinical supervision and ongoing training in evidence-based practices. The Behavior Interventionist will work together with Clinical Assistants and Clinical Supervisors to teach children with ASD new adaptive skills (e.g., language, functional communication, functional play, pro-social behaviors, self-help, etc.). All of the client's programming is developed and individualized by the Clinical Supervisor, based off of an assessment of skill level, and taught in a one-on-one environment with many opportunities for generalization and maintenance. JAC's practice is centered in Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) and intensive behavior intervention.

Behavior Interventionist Qualifications:

Successful candidates* must have the following qualifications:

- Are at least 18 years of age
- Successfully pass a federal criminal background check
- Live local to the center interested in working at
- Own a registered and insured vehicle that provides reliable transportation
- Own a cellular phone that provides reliable communication
- Complete CPR and RBT Training within 3 months of hire date
- Are able to address parental concerns in a professional manner
- Enjoy interacting with children, display patience, have high-energy and a positive attitude, are fun and creative, and love to play

Preferred candidates have the following qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree
- Meet one of the following:
 - A. Has an Associate's Degree in psychology, education, ABA, or a related field of study; or
 - B. Has 48 college credit hours and is currently enrolled in a related academic program

**Note: Specific training in the field of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) will be provided to all successful candidates.*

Behavioral Interventionist Hours and Schedule:

- Part-time: 10-29 hours/week
- Full-time: 30-40 hours/week

Behavior Interventionist Pay Rate:

The Behavior Interventionist/New Hire rate in New Mexico is \$9.50/hour and \$12/hour in Colorado until you complete RBT training, at which time a pay raise will be given. Once you receive your RBT certification, a second pay raise will be given of which the hourly rate will be negotiated.
