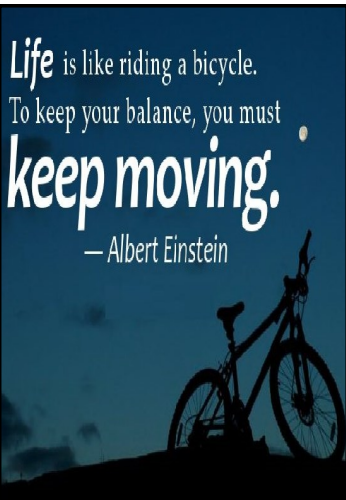

Tech Community Outreach Coordinator, administered Accuplacer Testing, which is a free placement test required of all new Ivy Tech students, to eight new students.

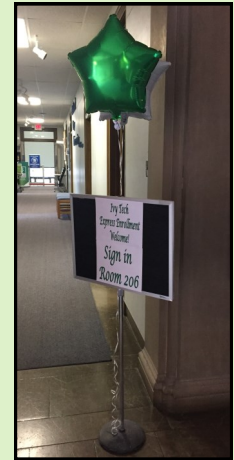
Reed was assisted by three additional Ivy Tech, Bloomington, personnel: Andrew Call, Nikki Harp and Jennifer Barker.
