TS 189 – Application for Admission Appendix C: Composite Data Element Explanation and Examples

Composite data elements are used to link a number of data elements together. Only one composite data element is used in this implementation of TS 189. It is the Composite Unit of Measure (C001).

The structure of Composite Data Element C001 permits reporting of a unit of measure that is a combination of units found in the Data Element 355 code list, such as days per month. The structure consists of a base unit of measure, an exponent, and a multiplier. Defaults for the exponent and the multiplier are 1. Each Data Element in C001 is separated by a sub-element delimiter.

Some values from the list of codes for Data Element 355:

- DA Days
- HR Hours
- MJ Minutes
- MO Months
- WK Weeks
- YR Years
- ZZ Mutually defined

Some Composite C001 Examples using these values – where ":" is the sub-element delimiter

- HR:::DA:-1 Hours per Day
- HR:::WK:-1 Hours per Week
- DA:::WK:-1 Days per Week
- DA:::MO:-1 Days per Month
- DA:::YR:-1 Days per Year
- MO:::YR:-1 Months per Year
- WK:::MO:-1 Weeks per Month
- WK:::YR:-1 Weeks per Year
