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# PROOF By H.A.M.

Apart from us the world knows nothing about Jesus. The world gets to know Him by what it sees in each of us. Here's John 17:10, "All I have is yours, and all you have is lative. And glary has come to like through them." Every single Christian must be an evangelist. Lip service without deeds is fruitless. James 2:14-18 reads, "What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save them? Suppose a brother or a sister is without clothes and daily food. If one of you says to them, 'Go in peace; keep warm and well fed,' but does nothing about their physical needs, what good is it? In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead. But someone will say, 'You have faith; I have deeds.' Show me your faith without deeds, and I will show you my faith by my deeds."

The tasks of evangelism are NOT based exclusively on external methods. They are proliferated through character, and ones relationship to and with God as we see here in John 17:17-19, "Sanetity tham by the truth; Your word is truth. As You sant We that the world, I have sant them into the world. For them I sanetity byself, that they too may be truth sanetitied." Jesus is the Word, our truth, and our means for sanctification, John 14:6, "Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the Ma. No one comes to the Pother except through We."

Can God use ignorant people, unlearned, untutored, and untrained? Consider the first disciples as outlined in 1 Corinthians 1:26-30, "Brothers and sisters, think of what you were when you were called. Not many of you were wise by human standards; not many were influential; not many were of noble birth. But God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong. God chose the lowly things of this world and the despised things—and the things that are not—to nullify the things that are, so that no one may boast before Him. It is because of Him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption ... what was emphasized here and everywhere."

Paul wrote this not with wisdom of words, not with human understanding, but in demonstrations of the Spirit and power, that your faith should not be in wisdom of men but in the power of God. Let's read **1** Corinthians **2:4-5** together, "The message I preached and how I preached it was not an attempt to sway you with persuasive arguments but to prove to you the almighty power of God's Holy Spirit. For God intended that your faith not be established on man's wisdom but by trusting in His almighty power."

Being sanctified means to be filled with the Spirit of God and to continually desire, above all, to know God better. Through His Holy Spirit we become more like Him. How? Sanctification is accomplished through God's love. Let me give you the definition of charity and then we will move on. Charity - In Christian thought, the highest form of love, signifying the reciprocal love between God and man that is made manifest unselfish love of one's fellow man.

Charity separates us from the world's ways, and it is part of that process. It's love He can use because God is it's originator, "The one who doesn't love has yet to know God, for God is love." (1 John 4:8) We must not allow our lives to contradict the message of love, as seen here in 1 Peter 2:11-12, "My divinely loved friends, since you are resident aliens and foreigners in this world, I appeal to you to divorce yourselves from the evil desires that wage war within you. Live honorable lives as you mix with unbelievers, even though they accuse you of being evildoers. For they will see your beautiful works and have a reason to glorify God in the day He visits us."

Love is the foundation for every good work, and dishonorable conduct is the foundation for every failure. Listen here to these Scriptures in 2 Timothy 2:20-26, "In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for special purposes and some for common use. Those who cleanse themselves from the latter will be instruments for special purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work. Flee the evil desires of youth and pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart. Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels. And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. Opponents must be gently instructed, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth, and that they will come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his will."

The Spirit of God works only through clean vessels, and we must always remember that love is a verb, not a noun. As seen here in **1** Thessalonians 3:13, "May He strengthen your hearts so that you will be blameless and holy in the presence of our God and Father when our Lord Jesus comes with all His holy ones." love that is exercised causes God to establish us perfectly. God's mighty power is rooted in the effectual service of love. The closer our walk with God, the more we are endued with the thoughts and spirit of sacrifice, which is to endure hardship, and look up to God in every trouble. It may seem a hard row to hoe, but no matter the circumstances, even in poverty, His endowing strength will shine.

First Samuel 2:8-9 tells us, "He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the needy from the ash heap; He seats them with princes and has them inherit a throne of honor. For the foundations of the earth are the LORD's; on them He has set the world. He will guard the feet of His faithful servants, but the wicked will be silenced in the place of darkness. It is not by strength that one prevails." And as the Apostle Paul tells us here in Colossians 3:23-24 (TPT), "Put your heart and soul into every activity you do, as though you are doing it for the Lord Himself and not merely for others. For we know that we will receive a reward, an inheritance from the Lord, as we serve the Lord Yahweh, the Anointed One!"

And reiterated here in **1** Peter 4:11, "If anyone speaks, they should do so as one who speaks the very words of God. If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory and the power forever and ever. Amen." God provides us with the strength of His glory. God's work, down to the simplest detail of our daily lives, can only be accomplished in God's strength, by the power of His Spirit working in us (**1** Corinthians 2:4-5).

Psalm 66:18 tells us, "If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened." So quite simply, holding on to sin or even un-forgiveness in our hearts will have an effect in our prayer life. That's what it says here in Hebrews 12:1 as well, "Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us." Furthermore, in Isaiah 59:2, it is clarified, "But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear." If we wish to continue fellowship with God we must, as it says here in 2 Timothy 2:19, "Nevertheless the solid foundation of God stands, having this seal: "The Lord knows those who are His," and, "Let everyone who names the name of Christ depart from iniquity." Iniquity is corruption.

God's Holy Spirit consists of pure love and is gentle. That's why we are instructed in *Ephesians 4:30*, "And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption." And yet again here in 1 Thessalonians 5:19 NKJV, "And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption." And here is the (TPT) Passion Translation of that same verse, "Never restrain or put out the fire of the Holy Spirit." Sin is like a millstone, it will always hold us down if we yield to it. A heart that harbors sin is resultant to anguish. The only true way to know "the peace that surpasses all understanding" (Philippians 4:7) is to break away from sin at all cost. Proverbs 13:15 makes clear, "Good understanding gains favor, But the way of the unfaithful is hard." And in 1 Samuel 15:22 Samuel says, "What is more pleasing to the LORD: your burnt offerings and sacrifices or your obedience to His voice? Listen! Obedience is better than sacrifice, and submission is better than offering the fat of rams." And one more time, from Proverbs 16:7, "When a man's ways please the LORD, He makes even his enemies to be at peace with him." And once again, from the Passion Translation, "When the Lord is pleased with the decisions you've made, He activates grace to turn enemies into friends."

In closing, let me say that we as Christians are saved to serve. Unless we are doing something for the Lord Jesus, we're not true to the vision He's given each of us. Reiterating, we are the PROOF the world sees. Love is service, and those who really love the Lord Jesus will want to serve Him unconditionally.

Dear Overcomers for Strist family, I hope this letter finds you in good spirits! As for myself, Praise the good Lord, I'm headed back to court! Our God is an awesome God! My appeal went through. I have a new lawyer, her name is Grace. I told you, "I didn't think I'd be here more than five years." Brother, you know that I have the faith of a mustard seed! Keep me in your prayers! As you know, I'll do the same. It's really starting to look like I really get to be part of Overcomers for Stirist ... C.P.

A Christian brother here, V.V., sends both his prayers and his love. He's a big guy with tattoos all over his face. He and I have been fellowshipping guite a bit and he shared a testimony with me from when you used to visit him in the county jail. It really lifted our spirits and I wanted to share it with the other OG+G family. This brother, V.V.'s, granddaughter was very sick and in the hospital. He said that he prayed really hard, in faith, asking God, "If only Wade would come see him, maybe he would go visit his granddaughter and pray healing over her." Then, the very next day he was told by the CO that he had an attorney visit so he went to the visit. When he arrived at the visit it wasn't the attorney, it was Wade! He said that was all God! God sent the specific man of God that I had requested! As he began to share with you his request he said you simply asked him, "Do you believe in healing? Do you believe that God wants to heal her? Do you believe that God WILL heal her?" As soon as V.V. answered "YES," you asked him to put his hands on the glass window with yours and you prayed a prayer of faith, God's Word. V.V. was excited when he learned just a few short days later that his granddaughter had recovered and was completely healed! And both you and V.V. agreed that all God is trying to get us all to do is to believe what His Word says, speak it and receive it! PRAISE GOD ... R.V.

I was waiting for a few things to materialize before I wrote to you all. These things are not a surprise but a confirmation of God's faithfulness. The claim is that this malfunction fractured her ribs, two vertebrates in her back and tearing a hole in the aorta of her heart causing her death, not the collision itself. These attorney's are asking for your cooperation and anything you might be able to testify about in producing any evidence you can to assist the family with in this new case." # Foot's Bible Study Rotes

# Isaiah 40:1-41:4

Instead of giving warning to the people of God's coming judgment, Isaiah comforts them. (40:1) At this point, Judah still has 100 years of trouble before Jerusalem would fall, followed by 70 years of exile. God tells Isaiah to comfort the people.

When your life seems to be falling apart, ask for God's comfort. You might not get out of the situation but you will gain God's peace and comfort as you go through it. That being said, sometimes our only comfort is in the knowledge that in the end we will be with God. (40:1-2)

It's only when we reach God's eternal world that we will obtain final solutions to our needs and problems. (40:6-8)

Even the strongest people, get tired at times, yet it's God's strength and power that never fades. He is never worn out to listen or help. It's in His strength that we obtain our strength. Don't forget that you can call on God to renew your strength when you feel as though life is crushing you and you cannot take one more step. (40:29-31)

Every generation gets caught up in their own unique kinds of problems. But what we need to take to heart is that God's plan includes all generations. He worked in the lives of your great-grandparents and shall continue to work in the lives of your great-grandchildren. God is the only being that can see 200 years from now, just as clearly as He could see 2,000 years ago. When you have worries or concerns for the future give them to God for only He knows the generations of what is to come as well as the generations of what has been. (41:4)

# Ephesians 1:1-23

Hold tight to your faith, obey God, like the Ephesians you will become known as a person who has strong faith in the Lord. (1:1)

God's grace is a voluntary favor given to those of us He has saved. Without God's grace, no one can be saved. (1:7-8)

## Psalm 66:16-20

Our confession should be a continual process due to the simple fact that we continue to mess up. Yet when confessing sins, we need to stop doing what is wrong. When we refuse to repent, we're putting up a wall between us and God. Surely, we can't remember every sin, but our attitude should lean more towards obedience. (66:18)

## Proverbs 24:8

Plotting to do evil can be as wrong as doing it because what you think determines what you will do. Left unchecked, wrong desires will lead us to sin. God wants pure hearts, free from sin, and planning evil brings sinful thoughts into our mind. Should you say, "Then I might as well go ahead and do it because I've already planned it?" No!! You have sinned in your attitude, but you have not yet harmed other people. Stop in your tracks and ask God to forgive you and put you on a different path. (24:8)

I'd like to share some thoughts with you all. We've either been around people or been the people who believe that if I was only in a different environment everything would be okay.

Now those of us who have applied that concept know it doesn't work for the simple reason because the same ole you keeps showing up!!!

Here's the deal, change has to start from within and until you can embrace a change from within it won't matter what environment you plant yourself in the middle of. You'll still be running into the same walls.

This is the point you trust in God to guide you on your journey of inward change. When you walk this type of path your environment will no longer matter. You can be who you strive to be and the environment cannot dictate who you are to be or how you will act.

About a year ago, maybe less, I was starting to lose trust, faith and care because I was focused on what I didn't have materially and all of my loses. Watching most of the brothers I was in church with every week I felt they were being ungodly. It was as though they were being so judgmental with each other, they might as well be throwing stones at each other. It seemed like it was always a 'me' contest. I didn't agree with it and I started to doubt Jesus. I'm sorry Jesus.

It was at that point that I gave up and started drinking hooch and lost the very little bit that I did have. I got hooked up with some Muslim brothers that accepted me the way that I was but there was always a bad feeling inside of me, like I was doing something wrong. They taught me to pray their way and gave me a Quran which I read and read. As I read the stories most were very similar. But nothing compared to the feeling that I felt in my heart and soul when I looked one of these new brothers in the eye and told him, "Jesus died for our sins." He looked at me and told me that I was wrong and that "I was sinning against Allah". I felt so much shame and hurt for Jesus in my heart and mind. Immediately I said, "I'm sorry Jesus, I repent."

I started to remember who had been with me every single step of the way. God has been with me through all of the gang violence, through all the drunkard long nights when I was unaware of where I was or what I was doing. He was the One that helped me to walk again after shattering all the bones in my left ankle and foot, and when I snapped my fibula in a riot. He was the One who seen me through some of the roughest jails and prisons in California. The One who didn't let me die when I was shot at six times and only one bullet hit me under my left knee. When I was stabbed He was the One that always heard my cry for help.

When I was in the world doing what I thought to be normal I came back home like the prodigal son and today, I feel more accepted than ever before. More than anything these last few months my eyes and mind have been opened. Sure I've made a couple of mistakes where I let pride get in the way along with protecting myself. But all in all, I see my mistakes now and with his help I correct my faults. I humble myself and I try to help the next person.

Just a short time back a young kid came on the yard and said that he had never been to prison. I will say that he smelled and people here were making an issue of it. I gave this kid the little bit of hygiene that I had, not knowing how I was going to get anymore. But you know what, I didn't care, and a million bucks couldn't give me the feeling that I felt about that decision.

A couple days later this other guy comes up to me and told me, "Hey, you know that kid you gave your hygiene to is gay, right?" I told him, "So!" Then he told me, "You know he sold that hygiene for some smokes, right?" Instantly I got mad and started on my way to confront the kid. On my way there something inside of me said, "Forgive them for they don't know." I knew it had to be Jesus speaking to me so I responded with, "Thank You Jesus" and I continued on to chow.

I feel through all of my life's mishaps and struggles I have been being molded to overcome for Christ and in turn help the next lost soul to understand God's love and I'm reminded of **1** Corinthians **13:11**, where Paul said, "When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put the ways of childhood behind me." With this I say that I am ready for whatever Jesus Christ wants for me to do. All these blunt numerous

signs aren't for nothing. If this is what He wants from me then I say, "His will be done" and I truly accept His invitation from the center of my heart.

I'm excited to break this cycle and do something different with my life. I'll admit that I worry a lot and I know that I shouldn't. I was adapted to that other way of living for so long that at times I'm still afraid of failing. I'm tired of being a failure. I refuse to continue to allow satan to keep pulling me down. Today, I'm willing to do and take whatever steps it takes to make a better life for me and my family.
