NEWS FROM THE COMMODORE

[This letter was emailed to all members on 5/17.]

Dear KYC Members,

Today, Governor Cuomo announced that NYS will align with recent CDC recommendations easing mask wearing and social distancing requirements for fully vaccinated* individuals, effective Wednesday, May 19. Over the course of the last year, we have followed the guidelines and mandates from NYS in an effort to protect our staff, members and guests. While today's announcement is certainly welcome news, it will undoubtedly raise questions regarding protocols at KYC. Based on the information learned today we are implementing the following guidelines:

- Masks and social distancing will no longer be required at KYC for fully vaccinated individuals.
- Unvaccinated individuals must wear masks and social distance inside the clubhouse, unless seated.
- Anyone who is not feeling well, vaccinated or not, should take precautions and not visit KYC.

KYC staff and members of your volunteer Board of Directors will not ask about a member's vaccination status. Instead, we will rely on each of you to act in an appropriate manner given the new guidelines. KYC is a place we can all enjoy together, much like we did last summer and every summer before. Regardless of your vaccination status or decision, we have plenty of space to allow everyone to enjoy the clubhouse and grounds as you deem appropriate. If you are vaccinated but still want to wear a mask indoors, feel free to do so. If you are uncomfortable with a gathering of people on the grounds, avoid them. Most of all, just be respectful of one another as we navigate our way through the summer. On a personal note, I believe today's announcement is further support for the public health benefits of vaccination. If you haven't yet been vaccinated, I would encourage you to consider doing so. As a final reminder, we open on FRIDAY NIGHT! I look forward to seeing you soon.
