What We Do?

MUSICAL OUTREACH

Individual musical room visits are aimed to provide stimulation and entertainment for bedbound residents. Various musical genres and topics are implemented taking into consideration the personal taste of each resident. The observation notes provided can be advantageous to the interdisciplinary team of health care professionals.

MUSICAL THEME GROUP

This is a musical group program intertwined with a theme that allows the residents to escape to different eras with delightful sounds sure to bring smiles around, and sway with melodies to create and relive memories. Examples of themes are April Showers, Advice Songs, Let's Get Away From It All, Century of Great Songs, and more!




What We Do?
