Newsletter Editor

Dancing

The cultural icon of Scottish dancing is promoted and encouraged through sponsorship and recognition of competitions/events. Dancing is promoted primarily regionally with currently no major Clan MacLeod award distributed for a particular level of dancing. Piping

Promoting, encouraging, and otherwise supporting traditional Scottish piping, primarily through sponsorship and recognition of events in the different Society Regions. Medals are distributed to those RVPs that have piobaireachd competitions as a token representing the MacCrimmon Quaiche.
