Minimize distracting background noises by muting your microphone. Remember to unmute if you would like to speak to the group.



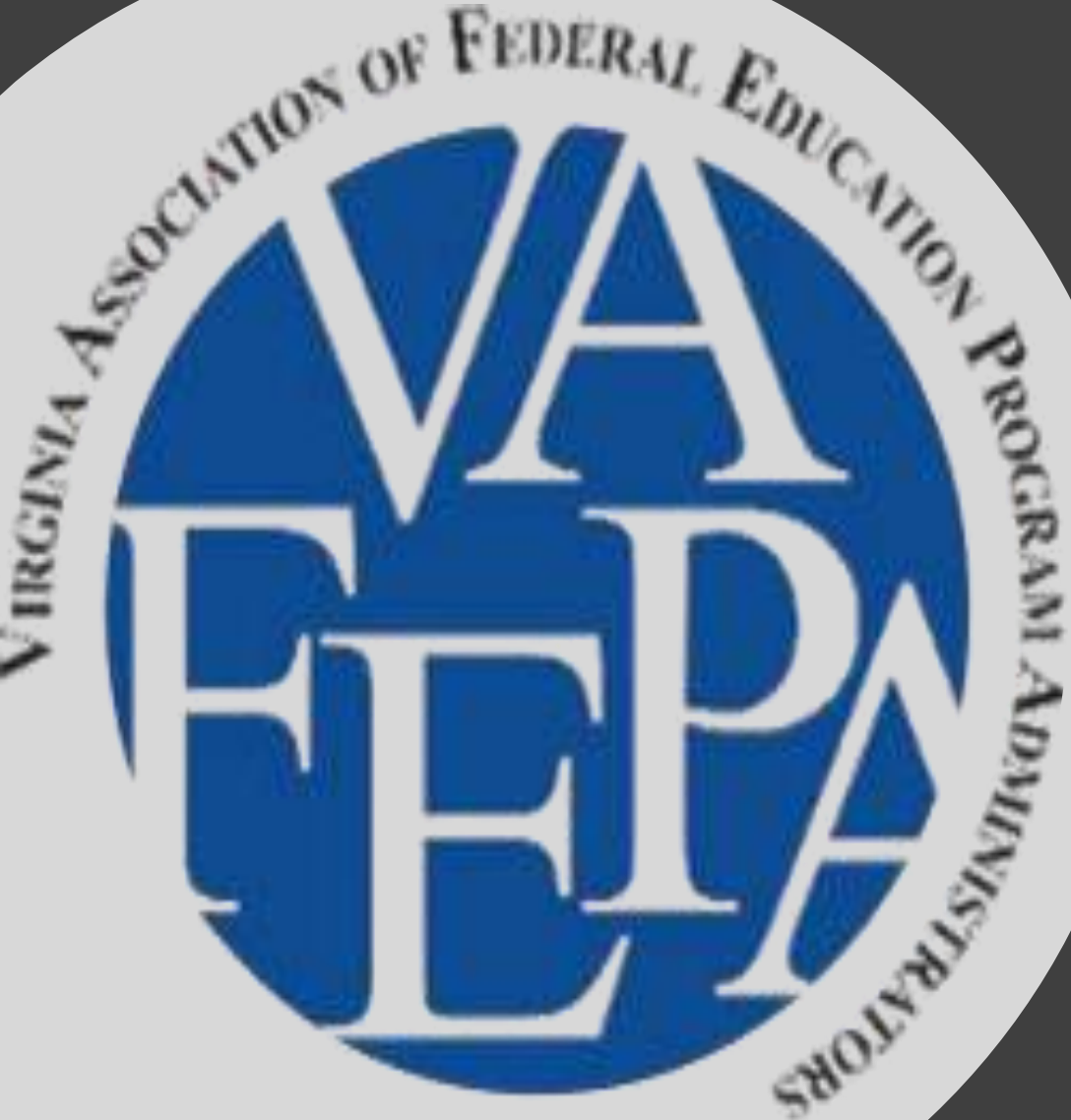
Turn on Your Camera

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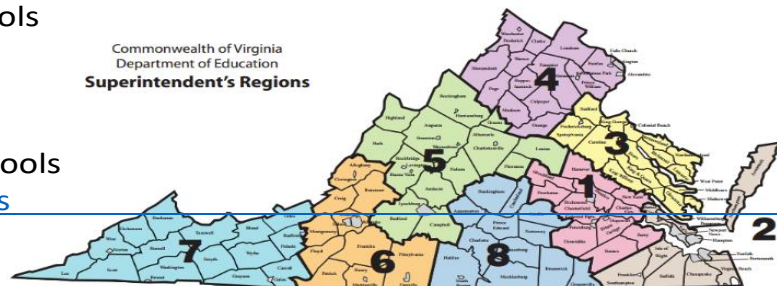
