Ladies and Gentlemen,

Please note that for 2017 there have been some changes in the Saltwater Charter Reservation rules. We are going back to the policy that trips have to be completely paid for 2 meetings before the trip date. There has been an increase in the amount of the deposit for each trip. No partial deposits will be accepted. We expect that these trips will sell out fast.

2017 Saltwater Charter Reservation Rules:

All club charters are available for reservation at the January meeting.

A **\$100 nonrefundable deposit** will be required to confirm your reservation for any trip.

Payment in full will be required **2 meetings prior to the departure date**. If payment is not received by 7:30 PM of the specified meeting night, your spot will be available to any interested party.

There will be no refunds until the Charter is full & the Club has been able to sell your reservation. The Club makes no guarantee that we will be able to fill your reservation once the Charter is full. All changes most go thru the Charter Master.

All charters are open to members and invited guests.


