Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Supervises and provides surveillance of swimmers and guests during pool hours, special events, and training sessions
- Responds to emergency situations in assigned zone
- Assists in communicating emergency situations outside of assigned zone
- Administers and coordinates emergency first aid as necessary
- Enforces the rules and regulations of the pool
- Advises aquatics management of unsafe and unsanitary conditions
- Provides superior customer service to all guests by assisting all in a polite and expedient manner
- Performs daily routine chores and maintenance of pool to ensure neat and orderly appearance
- Performing within American Red Cross Certification standards
- May be required to assist in front desk and concession stand tasks
- May be asked to help with swim lessons

Required Qualifications & Skills

- No experience required, training provided
- Must be at least 15 years of age
- Ability and willingness to achieve Certification in First Aid, CPR and American Red Cross Lifeguard Training
- Must be flexible regarding scheduling as it is based on business demands to include some weekend and holiday availability
- Must have the ability to work in extreme weather conditions
