

Flowering and Shade Tree Information

Bradford Flowering Pear

Bradford pear (*Pyrus calleryana* 'Bradford') is a spring-flowering tree that has been widely planted throughout the eastern U.S. in the last few decades. It is a popular tree that is frequently seen in nearly every city within its growing range. The Bradford pear grows 30 to 50 feet tall and 20 to 30 feet wide. It has a wider and more erect, branchier canopy than the species.

Chitalpa

Broadleaf deciduous tree, small to medium, 20-35 ft (6-10.7 m) tall, branches dense, spreading. Leaves alternate, occasionally opposite, to 20 cm long, narrow, tapering at both apex and base, dull green, glabrous above and shaggy soft hair below. Flowers in erect clusters (racemes), trumpet-shaped, resemble Catalpa, pink, yellowish center. Sun and partial shade. Blooms for several months during the summer. A tough, drought-tolerant plant.

Krauter Flowering Plum

The Krauter Vesuvius Purple Leaf Plum is a small tree, reaching 15 to 20 feet tall and spreading about the same distance wide. It has a dense, upright crown of many branches, and in spring they are covered in a profuse blooming of small pale-pink flowers.

Maple – Armstrong

Armstrong Maple is a stunning columnar shade tree with dazzling fall colors. This improved version of the Armstrong Maple boasts enhanced branching and a captivating display of golden yellow and orange leaves in autumn. Its large green leaves and uniform, dense canopy provide excellent shade and privacy. This exceptional tree promises to transform your landscape with vertical elegance and seasonal brilliance.

Maple – Autumn Blaze

For those who want a pop of red color in the fall, you should choose the Autumn Blaze Maple tree. This tree will provide spectacular color throughout the autumn season. Once the cool weather arrives, the maple's five-inch leaves begin to turn at the top of the tree. The beautiful color seeps down the entire tree's length as it is showered in bright red and orange-red hues. The Autumn Blaze Red Maple's color starts earlier and lasts longer than other tree varieties.

Maple – Red October Glory

Outstanding, reliable, bright orange to deep, reddish purple fall color - even in warmer climates. A tall form with a dense, rounded crown and large, medium green leaves in spring and summer. Foliage is held on the tree later into fall than with most cultivars. A superb choice as a high profile shade tree for larger landscapes.

Oak - Shumard

Shumard oak (*Quercus shumardii*) is a large, deciduous tree that reaches up to 30m in height. It has gray, furrowed bark and grayish-brown, dull, bud scales on the mature branchlets. The leaves are alternate and deeply lobed. Each leaf has seven to nine sharply toothed lobes that tend to widen slightly toward the tip. The 10-18cm leaves are dark green above, and paler green below with hairs clustered in the leaf axils.

Redbud – Forest Pansy

A deciduous, often multi-trunked understory tree with a rounded crown that typically matures to 20-30' tall with a slightly larger spread. It is particularly noted for its stunning pea-like rose-purple flowers which bloom profusely on bare branches in early spring (March-April) before the foliage emerges.

Weeping Double Flowering Cherry

This slow-growing ornamental tree makes the perfect showcase plant. The double-weeping cherry lends its elegance to any landscape with its reliable, unique blooms, thriving in moist soil. Use this tree as either a single focal point or paired to frame entryways-- this cherry is particularly striking when set against a dark evergreen background.
