

RUSSELL DANCEY

1905 - 1987

A Memorial Service is planned this Sunday, July 12 in Caseville United Methodist Church for longtime Sand Point resident Russell Dancey, age 82 of Detroit, who passed away Feb. 6, 1987 in Florida. The service begins at 6:30 p.m., and will be led by Dr. John Adams.

Mr. Dancey was co-founder of the New Era Potato Chip Company and a director of Frito-Lay and the Pepsico Corp.

He was a member of the Christ United Methodist Church in Detroit and was also active in supporting the Caseville United Methodist Church. In 1976, Mr. Dancey established the Opal Dancey Memorial Foundation to aid seminary students of all denominations to obtain their theological education.

He was also a trustee at Adrian College, where both he and his wife helped many students attain their college education. He was also a benefactor for the United Methodist Retirement Home in Chelsea, Mich.

He is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Fred (Betty) Godard, two grandsons and a granddaughter.
