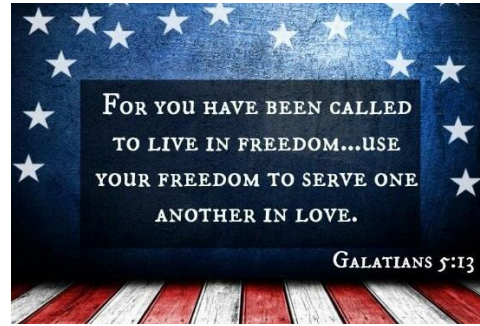

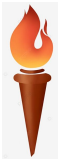


Dear church family,
