**Stations and Soup**

Join us *Fridays during Lent* for the beautiful devotion of Stations of the Cross followed by a Lenten dinner in Father McNamara Center hosted by the many different ministries of Saint Olaf Catholic Church.

**Did you know...?**

The Stations of the Cross, or Via Crucis, are commonly found in Catholic churches as a series of 14 small icons or images. They can also appear in church yards arranged along paths. The stations are most commonly prayed during Lent on Wednesdays and Fridays, and especially on Good Friday, the day of the year upon which the events actually occurred.

**Celebrate World Down Syndrome Day on 3/20/2022**

The amaZing 3.21k is a 2 mile fun run/walk to benefit Ruby's Rainbow (which provides scholarships to adults with Down Syndrome to go to college) and Reece's Rainbow (which provides grants for international special needs adoptions) held IN PERSON and VIRTUALLY for 2022. Down syndrome (also called trisomy 21) occurs when there are 3 copies of the 21st chromosome ... hence the reason for the 3.21k distance!
