THE EARTHQUAKE AND WHY IT HAPPENED

The earthquake struck in January 2010

The earthquake struck in March 2011 at around 3pm

It measured 8.9 to 9.0 on the Richter scale

It measured 7.2 on the Richter scale

It struck 65 km east of Tohoku at a depth of 30km and lasted for 6 minutes

It struck near the capital city of Port an Prince at a depth of 10km and lasted for 30-40 seconds
