 - i. Stitches, minor fractures, ear problems.

 - e. A 3-suite building: First suite is the Quick Care.
 - f. Middle is HSHS St. Anthony:
 - i. X rays, Ultra Sounds, Labs.
 - ii. Effingham OBGYN will be there 2 days a month, the 2nd and 4th Monday starting May 13th.
 - g. The end will be Springfield clinic.
 - i. In process of moving and will be opening soon.
 - ii. Will be looking to implement old building, possibly a new service.
