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negative marking can cause a sense of tension. A correct answer gives you +1 and wrong answer gives you -0.25 (in most of the exams)

60% of candidates leave all unknown questions, 10% run through all questions, 30% decide after looking into the paper

IF U LEAVE U LOSE

the 60% are biggest losers.

let us say u don't know 50 questions from the paper (OUT OF 200)

what should u do?

Three strategies

1. **NO RISK**- leaving 50 ques means u r answering for only 150, affects ur score badly

2. **HIGH RISK**- Guessing all 50 ques have a risk of losing 12.5 marks

3. **CALCULATIVE RISK**(*Best strategy chosen by experts)

U should guess those ques in which u can eliminate some of the options. After eliminating if u r remain with 2 options u can make a guess. Now your probability of choosing the correct answer is 50%

If u can answer 30 out of those 50 questions in this strategy, you may get at least 15 correct, +15 marks for correct answers and -3.75 for 15 wrong answers totally 11 EXTRA MARKS!! This will improve your chance of selection heavily
