ATV use at Elk Lake

<u>Children under the age of 16 operating ATVs MUST be under ADULT SUPERVISION and be TRAINED</u> in accordance with KRS 189.515.

ATVs must have an Elk Lake windshield sticker visibly displayed. These stickers may be acquired from the ELPOA office when supplying Proof of Ownership. Any ATVs leaving the Elk Lake area will be signed out in the same manner as a boat. This is primarily for the Member's protection against theft. ATV operators should respect the Elk Lake environment and the rights of others within the Elk Lake community.

No ATVs shall be operated in a careless, reckless, or negligent manner so as to endanger person or property.

Quiet hours are 11pm -8am. This includes loud vehicles and ATVs.


Any damage to person or property as a result of the operation of any vehicle, including ATVs, within Elk Lake, is the responsibility of the owner of the vehicle.

Grass carp released to control Elk Lake's aquatic plant problem.

As reported earlier, the Board voted to release Grass Carp to control the lakes' aquatic vegetation. This was after much discussion, research, and a visit from Jeff Crosby of Kentucky state fisheries. It was decided to use a measured approach over time.

We released 100 grass carp this year and will release 25 in both 2019 and 2020. We will keep an eye on the effect and modify our plan from there.

State stocking recommendations are 2-5 grass carp per acre. We have released a lower number to gage effect and have a diversified age population.

These fish can live longer than 20 years, and the 1,500 released into Elk Lake in 1985, all the same age and not reproducing, are now gone. By releasing them over many years we hope to control the problem long term.

Released were 26 fish over 12 inches and 74 fish 8-12 inches. We should start seeing results in two to three years.

They eat vegetation so should not be caught unless snagged, but if you do catch one, please release it. Each fish costs us about \$12 each.

Barbecue Pork

For pork:

6 tablespoons paprika
3 tablespoons granulated sugar
Scant tablespoon onion powder
Kosher salt and coarsely ground pepper
1 10-to-12-pound boneless pork shoulder
or Boston butt, rinsed and dried

12 soft hamburger buns, split Coleslaw, for serving

For the Barbecue Sauce:

2 cups ketchup
1/4 cup packed light brown sugar
1/4 cup granulated sugar
Freshly ground pepper
1 1/2 teaspoons onion powder
1 1/2 teaspoons dry mustard
2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
1/2 cup apple cider vinegar

2 tablespoons light corn syrup

Directions

If using a gas grill, preheat to high on one side; put soaked wood chips in a smoker box. Once smoking, reduce the heat to maintain a temperature of 275 degrees F and cook the pork, covered, on the cooler side of the grill.






