Priority Registration Information for Summer School and Fall, New Tuition Rates (Effective June 9, 2025), and Applications were emailed home on January 13th. Please be sure to read the Instruction Sheet prior to filling out your application. Please keep an eye on your inbox and contact the office if you do not receive the information by the end of the day. You will need to print your applications (one per child), fill them out, and submit them to the office no later than February 10th. Any applications received after the due date, may result in forfeiture of priority eligibility. Registration payments/deposits are due by February 18th.

February 18th – 21st will be a week of Celebrating Black History. During that week our students will learn about some influential black figures that have made an impact on our lives. Please be sure to talk with them and ask them what they have learned.

REMINDERS:

- Please be mindful of the traffic in the parking lot – especially at busy times of the day. Children should always be holding an adult's hand while in the parking lot. For the safety of everyone, be sure to follow the painted arrows, and drive slowly. So that everyone has a convenient place to park and drop their students off, please exit the parking lot after you have dropped off/picked up your child. Please do not use the parking lot as a place to socialize or let children run around. As a reminder, please only use designated parking spots to park. The greenery wall is not a parking space. Please also do not park in the area nearest the sidewalk and the building that would block the handicap parking space. That is not an allowed parking spot.
- For safety reasons, please use the hallway door (near the wall with the bins) when dropping your student off onto the big playground in the morning. There is a teacher there visually checking students in and keeping a count of children on the playground. Please do not send students out through any of the classroom doors. We appreciate your help with this.
- As a reminder, please walk with your child to their classroom or their cubby. We never want to see unattended children in the hallways or classrooms unsupervised.
- It is chilly in the afternoons. Please make sure that your child has a jacket available to wear. Please label EVERYTHING! We have found lots of jackets and other items with no names lately. Please label your child's items so that we can get them back to the correct owner.
