SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES  
TUESDAY, JANUARY 6, 2026, 6:00 P.M.





**Attendance:** Selectmen: Robert Flint, Dale Miner as well as members of the Public.

1. **Review/ Approve minutes.** Dale Miner moved to accept and approve December 23rd, 2025, minutes as written. Robert Flint seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept the minutes.
2. **Review/ Approve warrant.** Robert Flint moved to accept and approve the January 06, 2026, warrant. Dale Miner seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept the warrant.
3. **Grant Writing and Funding Webinar:** The Maine Municipal Association (MMA) is offering a grant writing and funding webinar designed for municipal staff and officials. Administrative Assistant, Robyn Anderson, and Select Board members plan to register for the webinar on Thursday, February 19, 2026, from 1:00pm – 5:00pm.
4. **Doug Smith & Terry Egan, Mountain Division Trail Progress:** Mountain Division Trail President, Doug Smith and Vice President Terry Egan presented to provide an update on the trails progress since their last visit with the selectmen in 2023. The proposed trail follows the Mountain Division Rail Corridor from Fryeburg to Portland. To date, four miles of trail have been completed in Fryeburg and six miles in Standish, Gorham, and Windham. Thirty-one miles of trail has been broken into six phases. The next phase is to create a trail from Fryeburg to Hiram. This is estimated to take place over the next one and one half to two years. State legislation has been passed providing for a “trail until rail” approach which allows provisions to replace rails in the future when economically feasible. A feasibility study has also been completed, looking at the cost of project. Mr. Smith noted that the Mountain Division Trail Board is looking for a representative from the Town of Baldwin to join the board.


