Administration: New from BSA & Troop 599

- . New BSA Membership Fee System
- . Effective April 1, 2024
- Annual Membership Fees will no longer be paid by the Troop with its Recharter.
- On November 1st, all current T599 scouts and adults will receive an email from BSA concerning renewal of their membership.
- The new BSA fees must be paid on-line to BSA by November
 15th



Administration: New from BSA & Troop 599

- Failure to pay the BSA fees on-line by December 31 will result in the lapse of membership.
- A lapsed scout will NOT be allowed to attend meetings or outings or to complete any advancement.
- A scout or adult can be reinstated without completing a new application during January by payment of their fees (and, possibly a late fee).





Administration: New from BSA & Troop 599

. The new fees paid on-line directly to BSA are:

•	Youth	\$85.00
•	Scouts Life (magazine)	\$15.00
•	Adult Leaders	\$65.00
•	Youth and Adult SHAC Insurance	\$ 6.00
•	MB Counselors (not also a CM or ASM)	\$25.00

. The new annual fee for Troop 599 will be \$75.00





Administration: New BSA Camping Policy

- . Effective September 1, 2023 for ALL adults camping overnight
- . Adult campers MUST be registered as a paid, adult leader, i.e., a Committee Member or Asst. Scoutmaster.
- . This requires: Completion of an Adult Leader application Payment of \$66 fee (\$60 to BSA and \$6 to SHAC)
- . Completion of Youth Protection Training (72 min) Completion of Completion of CM Training (102 min)




