## Libraries Rock!

#### June 4th - July 27th

Come join the fun... exciting programs, incentives galore! Don't forget to mark your calendars with our "special event" dates.

Participants will record the titles and/or number of pages for each book they read on a form provided by the library. The books must be recorded, simply checking books out will not count for the program. Only books checked out from the Garnett Public Library may be used. Books checked out June 4th or later may be counted. Reading must be turned in by 5:30 Friday, July 27th. ALL DEADLINES WILL BE KEPT. NO EXCEPTIONS

#### **Reading Requirements:**

<u>Preschool -1st grade:</u> \*PRIZES AWARDED BY NUMBER OF BOOKS READ\* Children may count any books in the children's area including non-fiction.

Prizes will be awarded at the following book levels: 10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90, 100, 125, 150, 175, 200, 225, 250, 275, 300.

The top ten readers will receive special recognition and a special prize.

<u>2nd-3rd grade:</u> \*PRIZES AWARDED BY NUMBER OF PAGES READ\* Children may count any books in the children's and junior section that have **30** or more pages, including paperbacks and non-fiction.

Prizes will be awarded at the following page levels: 200, 400, 600, 800, 1,000, 1,200, 1,600, 2000, 2,500, 3,000. The top ten readers will receive special recognition and a special prize.

<u>4th grade:</u> \*PRIZES AWARDED BY NUMBER OF PAGES READ\* Children may count any junior fiction, junior non-fiction, YA Fiction, YA non-fiction, adult fiction and adult non-fiction that have 50 or more pages.

Prizes will be awarded at the following page levels: 200, 400, 600, 800, 1,000, 1,200, 1,600, 2000, 2,500, 3,000. The top ten readers will receive special recognition and a special prize.

Prizes will include: pencils, bookmarks, books, food prizes and many other items.

Reading levels are based on grade completed. We encourage all children 1st grade and above to read on their own; however, parents may help if needed. If you have a child with special needs please visit with the staff and we will try to make accommodations.

#### A Few Quick Reminders

Prizes will be awarded throughout the program as goals are met. Please make sure the titles on your records are legible or they will not be counted.

The staff reserves the right to ask any child about the books he or she records having read. If the child cannot give a reasonable account about the story they will not be allowed to count the book. The staff may also refuse to let the child count the book if it is obviously below their reading level.

We would prefer it if the younger children were read to on an individual basis rather than a group of children being read one book, then all of them counting it - this encourages one of the objectives of the program - children and parents spending quality time together reading.

Special note to the parents – please help us out by bringing your children to age-appropriate activities.

This not only helps the staff with planning, but the kids have more fun as well.


